Talk for Grammar – bringing grammar to life

Course Overview:

Anyone who has looked at the Grammar, Punctuation and Spelling (GPS) papers since 2016 will know that, unfortunately, the naming of parts (and some of them very obscure) is gaining ground and additional terminology has been added. This course is designed to help teachers confidently rise to this challenge while integrating the grammar into model texts and activities that engage the children. In addition, we will visit classrooms and observe these strategies in action at Warren Road, an 'Outstanding' school and Talk for Writing Training Centre.

Course Content:

- Grammatical skills and knowledge (including all the tricky bits!)
- Fun, engaging, daily activities for word and sentence work.
- The importance of imitation.
- The progression of grammar from EYFS through to Y6.
- How to explore and contextualise grammar through shared reading and writing.
- Reading as a writer – creating writers' toolkits.
